- Governments are chosen by a free and protected vote of the people.
- Human rights, including the rights of women, Indigenous people, and people of different beliefs, races and sexual orientations are respected.

Journey of Extraordinary Wisdom

The Visioneers Course on Global Citizenship

The Course is based on the Journey of Extraordinary Wisdom, which features the wisdom of ten outstanding thought leaders. Each present the legacy of their life's work in a video of one hour each, and each presentation is integrated with the next so that the big picture of what must be done for the planet and to become a global citizen is laid out clearly.


The science behind the wisdom is described so that it is clear why we need to act and demonstrates how we can be successful.

The Global Citizenship course structure is outlined in 'Each One Teach One' format where the six competencies declared by the Council of Ministers of Education of Canada (CMEC) are integrated in the learning.

These are the six CMEC competencies:

- Learning to Learn
- Critical Thinking and Problem Solving
- Innovation and Creativity
- Collaboration
- Communication
- Global Citizenship and Sustainability







The goal of this course is to create a global mind change and a new literacy in global citizenship.

After 10 weeks, the course methodology asks each group of learners to teach what they have learned.

They are asked to consider applications in their own community and ideas for action as part of the course.

This acts as a review and prepares them to assist in teaching what they have learned or put it into action as they form and lead clubs and action projects.

The whole group project is then posted on the school platform for other schools to see.

The host school will then have multiple teachers to join their teachers to form clubs and to lead in new and positive ways that creatively promote a global perspective with exciting new local actions.

Students will emerge with minds newly prepared to see the big picture, to make good, decent choices.
