




Divine Wisdom and the Holy Spirit: The Forgotten Feminine Face of God by Anne Baring

The overarching statement about the meaning of Golden Peace includes the absence of war and much more...

It includes creating a safe harbour where:

- Maternity hospitals are safe for mother and child.
- Schools from nurseries and kindergarten to grade 12 to universities are places where students feel safe to pursue learning and make friendships and where bullying of any kind is unacceptable.
- Workplaces are safe and free of discrimination.
- Justice, diversity, truth telling and following the rule of law are honoured.
- The disabled, the elderly and the poor are treated with respect and nurtured to contribute.
- Governments are chosen by a free and protected vote of the people.
- Human rights, including the rights of women, Indigenous people, and people of different beliefs, races and sexual orientations are respected.

Looking after the Earth, the air, the water, ourselves each other and ensuring that all living creatures are respected is the prime underlying requirements of peace everywhere.

The Stakes Have Never Been Higher

The Visioneers Call to Action described above is issued at a time when the stakes have never been higher for the well-being of humanity and Earth. This in no way diminishes the hopefulness of the message, but rather underlines the urgency of its implementation. To understand the context in which action is to be taken is to increase the likelihood of its success.

With this in mind, let's review the situation now facing humanity.

At the end of the first quarter of the 21st century, we find ourselves living at the most perilous time in human history, not in terms of an impending cataclysmic event or major war, but in a quagmire of reinforcing interdependent global problems from which there appears to be no escape.

This is not a sudden development. It has been building over centuries, driven by a mindframe that sees the world and all of physical reality as a domain of separate entities in which human beings can exercise dominion by control and force. The result has been endless conflict between increasingly powerful human groupings, culminating in devastating wars between nation states, which reached its terrifying apex in two world wars in the 20th century and unleashed the threat of total annihilation through nuclear war in a devastating future.



At the same time, the mindframe of separateness has pitted humanity against the natural environment in which nation states and industry have competed for natural resources and laid waste to the physical landscape and built exploitative economies that are now cumulatively exceeding planetary boundaries for the continual operation of ecosystems on which all life depends.

The stark bleakness for the potential of biological life on the planet can not be overstated. This is entirely unprecedented in human history. No experience from the past has prepared humanity for the challenges now facing it.

That is the context in which we find ourselves.

Now, let's review the reasons to be hopeful.

Significantly, the science and technology that is driving the trajectory towards collapse can also be used to find a way out. However, this cannot happen while the operating mindframe of humanity is fixated on separation and competition.

As the danger has intensified in recent decades, pockets of enlightened thinking have emerged in the work of global thought leaders who see the danger and are leading initiatives to find solutions. But nothing has yet materialized to break the dominant mindset of competition and conflict, as clearly evidenced in the current global chaos fueled by trade wars.

But the Visioneers are focused on breaking this dominant mindset.

In the face of the challenges now confronting us, one question stands out in bold prominence:

How can humanity embrace a global mind change that steers the trajectory away from conflict and breakdown?

One thing seems clear. The solutions are not going to come from leaders of nation states who are too preoccupied in managing their relationships in the context of the existing paradigm. Ultimately, world leaders will need to enforce solutions, but they are unlikely to originate the solutions.

The greatest hope for humanity is that sufficient freedom and robustness of democratic institutions exist in the world for people to come together in new ways to learn from each other, to unleash their creative imagination and vision, and build on the positive values of their cultural and spiritual traditions to create the upshift, as envisaged by Ervin Laszlo, to find new ways to live together on planet Earth.

This is the call of the Visioneers. The genius and leadership for change already exists. The generations alive today are being challenged as never before to collaborate for life in a global civilization. This cannot be done with the old nationcentric thinking anchored in ideas of separation and destructive competition, but only with a new kind of cooperative leadership that is worldcentric and humancentric filled with belief in unity and oneness and fueled by the values of compassion, empathy, kindness and love.

A glorious future beyond our current imaginings lies in potential manifestation in which all people everywhere can flourish in joyful lives of positive, collaborative accomplishment.

There is no time to lose in bending every effort of will and creativity to the task of building that future.

That is the call of the Visioneers.
